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## Guided Prayer for Your Child During Exam Periods

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### Before Exams:

- 1. Create a calm atmosphere.**
  - Find a quiet, comfortable space where you and your child can pray together. This sets the tone for a focused and peaceful prayer.
- 2. Express Gratitude:**
  - Begin by thanking God for the gift of knowledge and the opportunity to learn. Encourage your child to reflect on the blessings of education.
